A memorial Mass for Timothy L. Hammond, 45, of Kankakee, will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Thursday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. Cremation rites have been accorded. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. He died Saturday (May 28, 2011) at his home. Arrangements are by the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais.

Mr. Hammond was born May 3, 1966, in Kankakee, the son of William and Eileen Kohl Hammond. He was a graduate of St. Joseph Grade School and Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School. He enjoyed fishing and hunting.
