Adrien A. Raymond, age 90, of Bourbonnais passed away Saturday, September 13, 2025 at the Illinois Veterans Home at Manteno. He was born February 16, 1935 in Kankakee, the son of Rene & Viola (Guimond) Raymond. Adrien married Colette Beauclerc on May 17, 1958 at St. Mary's Church in Reddick.

Adrien was the owner/operator of Raymond's Truck Stop. He enjoyed hunting, snowmobiling, golfing, and classic Mustangs.

Adrien was a veteran of the United States Army.

He was a former parishioner of St. Theresa Catholic Church and a current parishioner of St. John Paul II Catholic Church.
