Agnes Tarnow -- Chicago Agnes J. Tarnow, 99, of Chicago, and mother of a Bourbonnais resident, died Monday (July 23, 2007) at Merkle-Knipprath Nursing Home in Clifton. Visitation will be from 9 a.m. Saturday until the 10 a.m. celebration of the funeral Mass at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais. Rev. Theodore Suchy will officiate. Private graveside services will be held Monday in St. Mary's Cemetery, Evergreen Park. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made for Masses at St. Procopius Abbey in Lisle. Tarnow, whom she married Feb. 14, 1946, at St. Rita Catholic Church, Chicago, died Sept. 17, 1978.
