Albert and me were very close in the 1950s Kankakee. We shared paper routes delivering the Kankakee Daily Journal with Albert's route on the west side and mine on the east side. For additional spending money, we used wagons to collect cardboard and bottles from behind stores and haul them to the scrap yard. They paid by the pound so I would stand on the scale with the wagon to weigh in and because Al weighed less than me he would stand on the scale for the check out.

There were two movie theaters downtown that we would go to when the shows changed. Much of the time we cruised town on our bikes. Around 1957 Albert bought a Cushman Eagle motor scooter. At that time in Illinois it was legal to drive a 5-horsepower motor scooter at age 14. Of course, Albert souped-up the engine to make it faster. Al terrorized the Kankakee area that year with me on the seat behind him.

My memories of Al are like he was my brother. He made my world a wonderful place to be a kid. I look forward to Al showing me around heaven when my time comes.
