Albert J. "A.J." Belletete, age 95, of Kankakee passed away Monday, November 25, 2019 at Presence Heritage Village in Kankakee. He was born December 17, 1923 in Ashburnham, MA, the son of Louis & Emelienne (Charland) Belletete. Albert married Kay C. McClellan on March 28, 1944 in Camp Lejune, NC. She preceded him in death on May 8, 2014.

A.J. was an employee of Roper Corporation, retiring after 32 years. He then worked for Door Masters for 12 years. A.J. was a 4th degree member of the Knights of Columbus, a member of the Kankakee Elks Club, and a former KCTC Board member for 30 years. He enjoyed reading, watching old westerns, and square dancing. A.J. was a volunteer at St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee for 24 years.

A.J. was a veteran of the United States Marine Corp, having served during WWII.

He was a member of St Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee, where he served as a Lector and Eucharistic Minister.

Surviving are three sons and three daughters-in-law, Michael & Aleta Belletete of Burr Ridge, John & Sherrie Belletete of Bloomington, and Kevin & Elizabeth Belletete of St. Anne; six grandchildren, Anthony, Jennifer, Amber, Jacquelyn, Jessica, and Joe; nine great-grandchildren; two sisters, Yvanna Leger of Ashburnham, MA and Marguerite Miille of Leominster, MA; and one brother, Maurice Belletete of Athol, MA. In addition to his wife, Kay C. Belletete, A.J. is preceded in death by his parents.
