Visitation for Albertine Patricia Cotsones, 83, of Bourbonnais, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Friday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church in Bourbonnais.

Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery, Kankakee. She died Tuesday (April 30, 2013) at Prairieview Lutheran Home in Danforth.

Mrs. Cotsones was a loan counselor at State Savings & Loan/Olympic Federal, retiring after 19 years of service. She also worked at First Title Co./Courthouse Title. She was born Nov. 15, 1929, in Bradley, the daughter of Wesley L. and Cecilia Lambert Amiot. Her husband, Eugene Cotsones, whom she married May 19, 1951, died July 11, 1983. She was a volunteer at the Kankakee County Blood Bank and was also a blood donor. She graduated from St. Joseph Grade School in 1943 and from Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School in 1947. She was a member of Maternity BVM Catholic Church and a former officer of the CCW. One of Al's greatest pleasures was singing in the church choir. She also enjoyed dancing, embroidery, sports, baking holiday cookies and delicious Greek pastries, and taking care of everyone's needs.
