Alvin J. "Al" "Catfish King" Hines, 79, of Bourbonnais, died Saturday (May 15, 2010) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. Tuesday until the 7 p.m. services at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. Deacon Leon Fritz will officiate.
