Alex A. Bernardino, age 56, of Cary, and formerly of Bourbonnais, passed away Tuesday, March 17, 2020 at his home. He was born February 3, 1964 in Manila, Philippines, the son of Dr. Arcadio & Dr. Rustica (Amazan) Bernardino.

Alex was an employee of AMITA Health. He was a graduate of Bishop McNamara High School and Loyola University. He enjoyed biking and playing paintball.

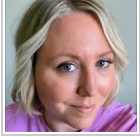

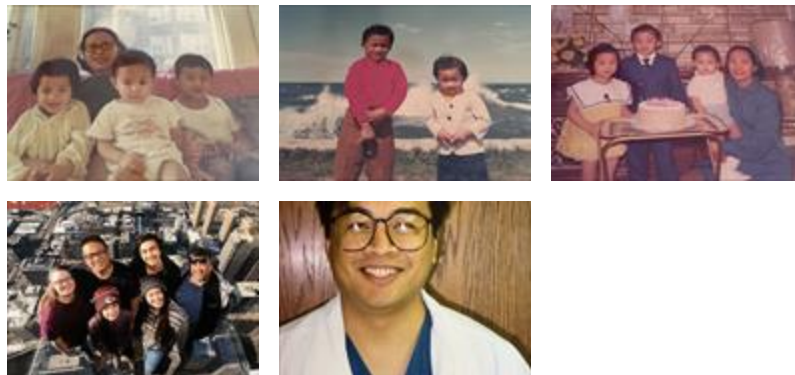

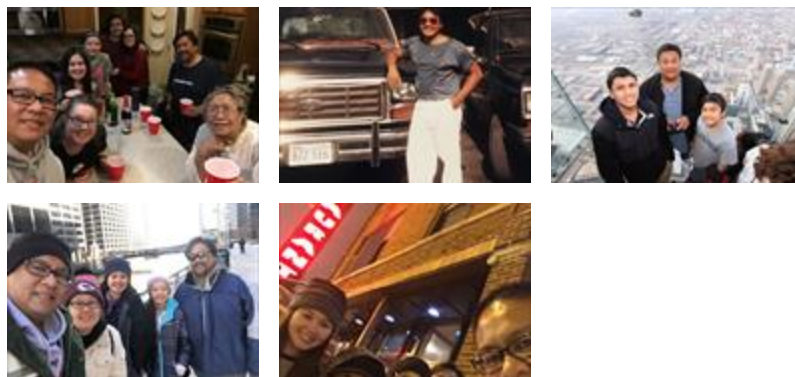
