



## Alexander Robert Simmons

March 21, 1979 - October 25, 2012

Memorial visitation for Alexander Robert Simmons, 33, of Elwood, will be from 4 p.m. Friday, Nov. 2, until the 7 p.m. memorial service at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home, St. Anne. Pastor Elaine Daugherty will officiate.

Cremation rites have been accorded. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to his daughter, Taylor Simmons trust fund. He died Thursday (Oct. 25, 2012).

Mr. Simmons was employed by Schneider of Elwood. Alex was born March 21, 1979, in Kankakee, the son of Mark and Julie Purcell Simmons. He was a member of St. Anne Catholic Church. He enjoyed doing electrical work and carpentry. His greatest joy was his daughter, Taylor, and his family. He also enjoyed camping, golfing, biking and spending time with his daughter.
