Alfred "Al" Dionne, 83, of St. Anne, died Monday (Oct. 26, 2009) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Wednesday at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home, St. Anne. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Thursday at St. Anne Catholic Church. The Rev.
