Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, Michael G. and Kitty Bossert of Kankakee; two daughters and sons-in-law, Linda and Ed Zimmer of Reddick, Kay and Neil Deupree of Janesville, Wis.; six grandchildren; 11 great-grandchildren; one brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Ivan and Annette Bossert of Reddick; and four sisters-in-law, Carolyn Curl Johnson of Taylorville, Margaret Curl of Manteno, Verna Bossert of Pontiac, Bonita Unz of

Streator; and many nieces and nephews. One infant daughter, four brothers and one sister are deceased.
