Visitation for Alphonse Jerome "Jerry" Cyrier, 76, of Bourbonnais, will be from 4-8 p.m. Wednesday at Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Thursday at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, Kankakee. Father Dennis Settles will officiate. Burial will be in Kankakee Memorial Gardens. He was born Sept. 30, 1928 in Bourbonnais, the son of Alphonse B. and Edna Marcotte Cyrier. He was employed as an engineer in the power house at Shapiro Developmental Center, retiring after 34 years. He served four years in the Korean War in the armored division. Surviving are his wife, the former Gloria Panoz of Bourbonnais, whom he married in 1985 at St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church, Kankakee; stepdaughter, Cynthia and Robert Kennedy of Kankakee; stepson, John and Sue Sertich of Clifton; four stepgranddaughters, Jennifer and Allen Sullivan, Lisa Ayres, Renne Kennedy and Christie Cox; and stepgrandsons, Matt Sertich and Josh Sertich. Also surviving are one sister, Dolores and Paul A. Boudreau; brothers, Justin and Patricia Cyrier of Bourbonnais, and Leonard and Emily Cyrier of Mendham, N.J.; three sisters-in-law, June Cyrier of Bourbonnais, Clara Cyrier of Kissimmee, Fla., and Rosalie Cyrier of Bedford, Texas; and numerous nieces and nephews. His mother and father; three brothers, Bernard, Roy and Gerald Cyrier; and two sisters, Rose Marie Grumish and Theresa Cyrier, are deceased. He enjoyed

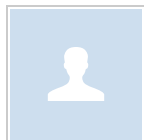

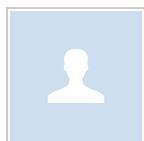
