Alvin Wendt -- Charlotte, N.C. Alvin Verl Wendt, formerly of Kankakee, died peacefully Thursday (Oct. 11, 2007) after a courageous battle with cancer at the Lake Norman Regional Medical Center in Mooresville, N.C. He was born Dec. 1, 1920, in Kankakee, the son of Paul and Hattie Dahling Wendt. He is survived by his loving wife of 62 years, Leona Marie Guimond Wendt, whom he married April 15, 1945. Alvin leaves behind two children, Constance Marie Holmes and husband, Raymond of Mooresville, N.C., and son, Keith Francis Wendt and wife, Laila Oinas of Sterling, Va. Grandchildren include Michael Propst of Columbus, Ohio and Caitlin Marie Ollis of Las Vegas and husband Nathan, Elizabeth Marie, Conor Francis and Hagan August Wendt of Sterling, Va.; and great-granddaughter, Juliana Marie Ollis. He is also survived by his brothers, Eugene Wendt and wife Lois, and Shirley Wendt and wife Jackie, all of Kankakee. In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by two brothers and a sister. Mr. Wendt was employed by American Marietta/Mobil Chemical in Kankakee from 1941 to 1964 as a technical director. He then took a position as vice president, research and development for Duron Paint Co. in Beltsville, Md. In his career, Alvin advised on many prestigious Washington area projects including the White House and U.S. Capitol Building. In 1982, Al retired to Hendersonville, N.C., where he and Leona enjoyed the North Carolina mountains for 21 years. They moved to the Charlotte, N.C. area in 2003 to be closer to their daughter.
