



## Ambrose N. Dyon

March 11, 1910 - April 7, 2011

Visitation for Ambrose N. Dyon, 101, of Kankakee, formerly of St. Anne, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon-Houk Funeral Home, St. Anne, and from 10 a.m. Friday at the First Presbyterian Church of St. Anne, until the 11 a.m. funeral services. The Rev. Lori Keller Schroeder will officiate.

Burial will be in Kankakee Memorial Gardens, Aroma Township. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or to the First Presbyterian Church of St. Anne. He died Thursday (April 7, 2011) at the Miller Center in Kankakee.

Mr. Dyon was a tool and die maker at A.O. Smith Corp., retiring after 23 years of service. He was born March 11, 1910, in St. Anne, the son of Clarence W. and Edna Allain Dyon. He was a member of the Royal Neighbors and the St. Anne Masonic Lodge. He repaired clocks and appliances and was an avid outdoorsman, hunter and trapper.

Surviving are his wife, the former Cleva Hubert, of St. Anne, whom he married March 18, 1936, in Crown Point, Ind.; one son, William R. Dyon, of Kankakee; one daughter and son-in-law, Betty and Albert Biggs, of Meridian, Texas; five grandchildren, Lisa Altman, Jim Dyon, Michael Dyon, Margaret Stenger, Shauna Morgan; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two brothers, LaVern Dyon and Russell Hollenbeck; and two sisters, Florabelle Nusbaum and Mabeleen Alberts.

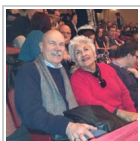
