



## Ambrose J. Reneau

July 16, 1928 - September 8, 2012

A memorial Mass for Ambrose J. Reneau, 84, of Chebanse, will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at Sts. Mary and Joseph Catholic Church in Chebanse, where he was a member.
