Sherrill, whom she married May 5, 1933, in Kentland, Ind., died Nov. 1, 1987. She was a member of Aroma Park United Methodist Church. She was also a member of the Eastern Star. She was involved with the Salvation Army Seniors, visited with seniors at the Azzarelli high-rise, and was Granny with Catholic Charities. She loved her puzzle books and Lawrence Welk. Surviving are two sons, James Sherrill and Mark Sherrill, both of St. Anne; one daughter and son-in-law, Kay and Ronald Smith of Bourbonnais; several grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren; and one sister, Agnes David of Florida. Deceased are one son, Wesley; two infant children, five brothers, and four sisters.
