Angelo Palikaris -- Lafayette, Ind. Angelo Palikaris, 84, of Lafayette, Ind., formerly of Kankakee, died Saturday (Feb. 18, 2006) at Home Hospital in Lafayette, Ind. Visitation will be from 5-8 p.m. today at the Hippensteel Funeral Home, 822 N. 9th St., Lafayette. Services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Tuesday at Annunciation Greek Orthodox Church, Kankakee. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens. Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, is in charge of local arrangements. Mr. Palikaris retired as a lab technician from Lafayette Water Works Co. in 1987. He had also worked for General Telephone Company as a data processor. He was born Feb. 9, 1922, in Kankakee, the son of Greek immigrants, Spiros and Angeliki Kaloutsis Palikaris. He served in the U.S. Coast Guard during World War II as a radar operator on the U.S.S. Oberon in 1942 and then on the U.S.S. J. T. Dickman in 1944. He was a 1940 graduate of Jefferson High School and attended Purdue University. He was a member of Holy Trinity Greek Orthodox Church, St. Alexis Orthodox Church and the American Legion Post 11. He enjoyed traveling, reading about ancient history, basketball and organizing Jefferson High School reunions. Surviving are his wife, the former Niki Neckopulos, whom he married Jan. 20, 1952, in Kankakee; one daughter, Angela Palikaris of Lafayette; several nieces and nephews; and godson, Tassos Dardas. Deceased are one daughter, Athanasia "Ann" Palikaris; and his aunt

and uncle, Nicholas and Christina Palikaris, who helped his father raise him after the death of his mother.
