Anthony Ciaccio -- Kankakee Anthony J. Ciaccio, 85, of Kankakee, died Tuesday (Dec. 27, 2005) at ManorCare Health Services in Kankakee. Visitation will be from 3-7 p.m. Thursday at Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, officiated by Rev. Charles Wheeler. Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. Mr. Ciaccio was born May 4, 1920, in Chicago Heights, to Joseph Ciaccio Sr. and Rose Peri Ciaccio. Surviving are his wife, the former Rose Mary Pesco of Kankakee, whom he married June 22, 1947, in Chicago; three sons, Joseph of Bourbonnais, S. Also survived by daughter-in-law Mary Chris Ciaccio; and sisters-in-law, Theresa Ciaccio and Lanecia Ciaccio. He served in the United States Army during World War II, 1941-1945. He owned and operated a corner grocery store in Kankakee for 25 years and also worked at the Kankakee Roper. He was a member of the Kankakee VFW for 60 years and a lifetime member of St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church. He was preceded in death by his parents; brother, Joseph Jr.; and daughter-in-law, Sheila.
