Arletta Menard -- Bourbonnais Visitation for Arletta M. Menard, 80, of Bourbonnais and longtime Kankakee resident, will be from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon-Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Friday at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, Kankakee. Father Charles Wheeler will officiate. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. She died Sunday (Aug. 17, 2008) at her home. Mrs. Menard was an LPN at St. Mary's Hospital and Bourbonnais Terrace. She was born July 17, 1928, in Salina Township, the daughter of David and Myrtle Bastien Jones. Her husband, Paul L. Menard, whom she married Oct. 17, 1948, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, in Kankakee, died Jan. 8, 1996. She was a member of St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, where she sang in the choir and helped direct the RICA program. She enjoyed crocheting, cooking, gardening, traveling, reading, music and theater.
