Arnold C. Berens, age 87, of Chebanse passed away Monday, October 22, 2018 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee. 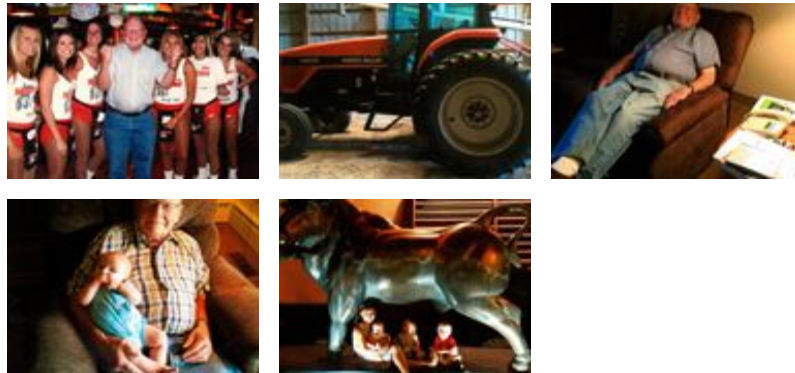
