Arnold "Arnie" Joseph Joubert, age 76, of Kankakee passed away Sunday, January 16, 2022 at his home after a three and a half year illness. He was born May 19, 1945 in Bradley, the son of Roland & Alexine (Guenette) Joubert. He married Margaret Dionne on February 6, 1965 at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley.

Arnie was employed by Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee for 40 years as a Computer Operations Supervisor. He retired in January 2014.
