



Arthur E. Cagle

Visitation for Arthur E. Cagle, 76, of Kankakee, will be from 4:30 p.m. to 7 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday.

Burial will be in Kankakee Memorial Gardens, Aroma Township. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. He died Sunday (Aug. 26, 2012) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee.

Mr. Cagle was a teacher for almost 30 years for Kankakee School District 111 and served on the board of directors of the Kankakee Federation of Teachers Credit Union for several years. After retiring from the school district, he worked for Good Shepherd Manor in Momence for 11 years. He was born Jan. 14, 1936, in Herrin, the son of Arthur M. and Audrey Helen Cagle. He was a graduate of Marion High School and Western Illinois University. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army and was commander of the Bradley American Legion Post 766 before he became ill. He enjoyed singing tenor with the Something Special Singers, traveling many places, reading and sports. He was a former IHSA (Illinois High School Association) sanctioned umpire who also coached Little League, and was an active member of the euchre club for many years.
