Arthur L. "Art" Duffield, 76, of Kankakee, died Wednesday (Nov. 3, 2010) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Friday at the Clancy-Gernon- Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, where services will be held at 11 a.m. Saturday. Pastor Andy Hansen of the Open Bible Church in Kankakee will officiate. Burial will be in Mound Grove Gardens of Memory. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the family wishes. Mr. Duffield retired from Gould National Battery in 1996 after 37 years of service. He was born Sept. 26, 1934, in Kankakee, the son of Arthur L. and Nellie Sturgeon Duffield.
