Arthur George Marlaire, 89, of Bolingbrook, formerly of Bradley, died Friday (Jan. 15, 2010) at Advantis Hospital in Bolingbrook. Visitation will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Monday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais, with a 7 p.m. wake service. A 10 a.m. funeral Mass will be celebrated Tuesday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. The Rev. Anthony Nugent will officiate. Interment will be in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery, Elwood.
