Audrey C. LaRocque, 92, of Bradley, died Thursday (Jan. 1, 2009) at Bradley Royale Health Care Center. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. Father Tony Nugent will officiate. Burial will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery. Memorials may be made to Hospice of Kankakee Valley or the Federation of the Blind. Mrs. LaRocque was a former employee of the Kankakee County Treasurer's office. She was born July 29, 1916, in St. Anne, the daughter of William and Louise Pombert Hiser. Her husband, Edwin J. LaRocque, whom she married May 20, 1938, at St. Anne Catholic Church, died Oct. 30, 1976. She was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley and the CCW. She was also a founder of Birthright of Kankakee County, a member of Daughters of Isabella, and the Kankakee Heartland Chapter of the Federation of the Blind. She was an avid card player and enjoyed crafts. Surviving are two sons and one daughter-in-law, David L. LaRocque of Bourbonnais, William and Melody LaRocque of Kankakee; two daughters and one son-in-law, Mary Margaret Cunningham of St. Pete Beach, Fla., Kathleen and James Regnier of Bourbonnais; eight grandchildren and six great-grandchildren; one brother, Harlan Hiser of Kankakee; one sister-in-law, Bernice Hiser of St. Anne; and special caregiver, Tara Prue of Bradley. 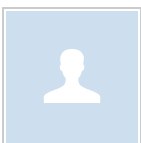
