He was born Sept. 18, 1922, in Essex, the son of Andrew and Ella King Ruder. His wife, the former Leonie Crevier, whom he married Oct. 27, 1946, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, Kankakee, died Feb. 18, 2003. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and received the Silver and Bronze Stars. He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Third and Fourth Degree; a member of the Elks, the Moose and the Manteno American Legion Post 755. He was former president of the McNamara Huddle Club. He enjoyed golfing. Surviving are four sons and daughters-in-law, James and Suzy Ruder of Kankakee, Rodney and Rita Ruder of Normal, William and Mary Ruder of Manteno, Theodore and Karen Ruder of Middletown, Conn.; one daughter and son-in-law, Mary Lee and Joe Greco of Algonquin; three sisters and two brothers-in-law, Marcella Egges of Milwaukee, Wis., Mary and Jules Giardina and Adelia and Richard Loiselle, all of Bourbonnais; 13 grandchildren and six great-

grandchildren.
