Visitation for Barbara A. She died Tuesday (Aug. 17, 2010) at Riverside Medical Center following an extended illness. Mrs. Johnson, along with her husband, owned and operated CIBC of Illinois Inc. She was born May 6, 1962, in Joliet, the daughter of Marion and Genevieve Dumas Foltz. Her first husband, Scott Schultz, died Jan. 7, 1994. She was the former ambassador of Kankakee Valley Chamber of Commerce and was a supporter of South Pointe Youth for Christ. She was a 1980 graduate of Herscher High School and a member of College Church of the Nazarene. She enjoyed reading, listening to music, playing board games and cards with her family and decorating her homes. Surviving are her husband, William W. "Bill" Johnson, whom she married April 20, 1996, at College Church of the Nazarene; two sons and daughters-in-law, Brock and Kristen Schultz, of Aroma Park, Brandt and Asya Schultz, of McGuire Air Force Base, New Jersey; two daughters, Brynn Schultz and Olivia Johnson, both of Kankakee; two grandchildren, Bryson and Kaiden Schultz; her mother, Genevieve and

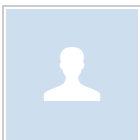
