Betty J. Martin, 84, of Bradley, passed away Friday (Jan. 22, 2016) at Presence Our Lady of Victory Nursing Home in Bourbonnais.

She was born Jan. 1, 1932, in Bradley, the daughter of Ovide and Verena Allgaier Martin.

Betty was a retired health-care provider. She also had been a Sister with the Springfield Dominicans from 1950-1982. During that time, Sr. Rebecca served as a teacher and principal at a number of schools in Illinois that the Springfield Dominican Sisters ran. She also was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Bradley. Betty was active as a lector, choir member and eucharistic minister.

Surviving are her brothers, Homer and Mary Martin, of Bradley, and Harry and Mary Martin, of Kankakee; and several nieces and nephews.

Preceding her in death were her parents; two brothers, Arthur and Robert; and two sisters, Dorothy Byrne and Leola Glassford.
