Blayne E. Nusbaum Sr., age 62, of St. Anne passed away Sunday, August 8, 2021 at Vibra Hospital of Northwestern Hospital in Crown Point, IN. He was born February 26, 1959 in Kankakee, the son of Eugene & Doris Mae (Meier) Nusbaum. Blayne married Glory Post on August 10, 2019 at First Presbyterian Church in St. Anne.
