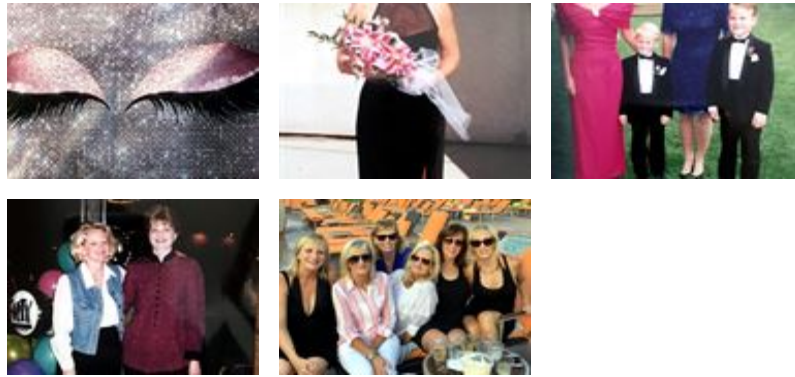

We were going to make plans to get together some time this summer. She was one of my best friends, I met her, when I started dating Greg Countryman, he was friends with Rick Myers. The four of us had lot of funny together. We went camping together, and went to the dunes in Braidwood, because both of the guys had Jeep's. I remember how Brenda and I were so scared of riding in those Jeep's! She was my rock, when my husband was killed in a car accident at 25 year old. She was always there for me. I had 3 small children under the age of 3. If I needed to going anywhere she would watch my children. Jason and my son Bryan were a year apart. She was a great listener, and never judge anyone. We both worked at St, Mary's, I was in data processing and she was in admitting. I had to leave St Mary's and move to Ottawa because Greg worked at the nuclear plant in Mazon IL. My husband and I would visit Brenda and Rich often, when we would came back to town, and they would come visit us in Ottawa. Unfortunately I was not able to make it to her memorial, because I got my second covid shot on Monday, and I was feeling ill on Tuesday. She always made a point to call me on my birthday, April 27. It was sad to not be able hear her, Happy Birthday greeting on Tuesday. I will miss her immensely! I'm sure her memorial was wonderful, with a lot of great stories about her.
