Brent Wagner -- Bonfield Brent M. Wagner, 65, of Bonfield, died Sunday (June 11, 2006) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital, Kankakee. Memorial visitation will be from 9 a.m. Wednesday until the 11 a.m. memorial service at the Bonfield First United Methodist Church. Rev. John Cross will officiate. Clancy-Gernon-Hertz Funeral Home, west Kankakee, is in charge of arrangements. Mr. Wagner worked in sales and delivery for a propane company and also farmed. He was a member of the Bonfield First United Methodist Church, where he was Sunday school superintendent, on the Sunday parish committee and a member of the choir. He was a member of the Kankakee Masonic Lodge 389, and a charter member of the Bonfield Lions and Salina Sportsmen's Club. He loved to travel, especially to his cabin in Colorado, and sing Christian music. Surviving are his wife, the former Jacquelyn Hertz, whom he married March 30, 1963, at St. Mark United Methodist Church, Kankakee; and two daughters, Nancy Jo Wagner of Bothell, Wash., and Linda Kay Wagner of Estes Park, Colo. Deceased are his parents and stepmother, Ora Wagner.
