Henry "Bruce" Cullins, 57, of Bourbonnais, died Tuesday (March 1, 2005) at his residence. Visitation will be from 4-8 p.m. Friday and from 9-9:45 a.m. Saturday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Saturday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais, where he was a member. Interment will be in Maternity BVM Cemetery, Bourbonnais.
