He received an associate's degree in criminal justice from Kankakee Community College. He was currently the president of the Kankakee Heartland Chapter of the National Federation of the Blind. He loved music, hunting, fishing and NASCAR racing, especially Dale Jarrett. Surviving are one son, Seth Scott Turner of Bradley; his parents of Salem, Ark.; and two uncles, George (Ellen) Turner and Robert Turner, both of Arkansas. His grandparents are deceased.
