Byron M. "Shorty" Regnier, 84, of Manteno, formerly of Bradley, died Saturday (Dec. 12, 2009) at the Illinois Veterans Home at Manteno. A memorial visitation will be held from 9:30 a.m. Wednesday until the 10:30 a.m. memorial service at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. The Rev. John Antczak will officiate. Inurnment will be in Abraham Lincoln National Cemetery, Elwood. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the Bradley Lions Club or to the family wishes. Mr. Regnier was retired from General Oil Equipment. He was born Feb. 24, 1925, in Beaverville, the son of Henry and Cora LaRue Regnier.
