Carl Benoit -- Bourbonnais Visitation for Carl M. Benoit, 58, of Bourbonnais, will be from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m. Thursday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 11 a.m. Friday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, where he was a member and Eucharistic minister. The Rev. Richard Pighini will officiate. Burial will be in All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Memorials may be made to the family wishes. He died Monday (Jan. 28, 2008) at Northwestern University Hospital, Chicago. Mr. Benoit was an employee of CSL Behring (Armour Pharmaceutical) for 35 years. He was born April 7, 1949, in Kankakee, the son of Lawrence and Lorraine Paquette Benoit. He was a graduate of Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School and attended Kankakee Community College. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army.
