Visitation for Carl J. Sutherland, 88, of Kankakee, will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at St. Patrick Catholic Church, Kankakee. Entombment will be in Mount Calvary Cemetery. Memorials may be made to Alzheimer's research or for Masses. He died Wednesday (March 11, 2009) at Provena St. Mary's Hospital. Mr. Sutherland was a retired carpenter from Local 496 and a sheet metal worker. He was a founding partner of Holohan & Sutherland Sheet Metal and S&S Sheet Metal. He was a developer of Park Lane Manor Subdivision. He was born Sept. 25, 1920, in Zelma, Mo., the son of Charles and Alice Gibson Sutherland. His first wife, the former Darline M. Dandurand, whom he married April 20, 1946, at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church, died May 13, 1994. He later married the former Reva Ditzler Hebert May 5, 1996 at St. Patrick Catholic Church. She died Sept. 12, 2005. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army Air Corps serving during World War II in the China-Burma-India Theater of Operations. He was a member of the Aroma Park American Legion and the Kankakee VFW Vintage Squadron. He was also a member of St. Patrick Catholic Church, where he was a member of the Holy Name Society and a church usher. He enjoyed making clocks, listening to music and traveling. Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, John and Melinda Sutherland of Bonfield; two daughters and sons-in-law, Karen and Greg Salisbury of St. Anne, Rose and Pat O'Connor of Irwin; two stepsons and one stepdaughter-in-law, the Rev. Daniel J. Hebert of

Anchorage, Alaska, Jerry and Cindy Hebert of Bradley; three stepdaughters and stepsons-in-law, Lucille and Bill Etzel of Bourbonnais, Marilyn and Mark Gibson of Decatur, Alice and Kevin Simonds of Algonquin; eight grandchildren, seven stepgrandchildren, 11 great-grandchildren and 11 stepgreat-grandchildren. Deceased are one stepgrandson, Andrew Simonds; two sisters, Thelma Sawyer and Lena Rapier; and three brothers, Albert, Ivan and Dale Sutherland.
