Carlo J. Allegro, age 78, of Bourbonnais passed away Thursday, December 5, 2019 at his home. He was born June 12, 1941 in Chicago Heights, the son of Mario & Anne (Fragale) Allegro. Carlo married Clarice Robinson on July 1, 1977 at St. Paul's Lutheran Church in Kankakee.
