Carol V. Schierholz Erzinger, 84, of St. Anne, passed away peacefully Sunday (April 21, 2013) at her home, surrounded by her family. 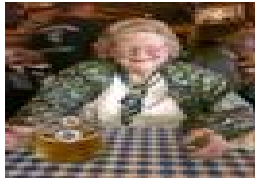
