Carol Lang, 57, of Bourbonnais, passed away Wednesday (Dec. 26, 2012) at Riverside Medical Center, Kankakee, after a yearlong battle with cancer. Visitation will be from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. Sunday, with a 5:30 p.m. rosary service, at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. A funeral Mass will be celebrated at 10 a.m. Monday at Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais, where she was a member. The Rev. Richard Pighini will celebrate the Mass. Burial will follow at All Saints Cemetery, Bourbonnais. Carol was born Sept. 17, 1955, in Kankakee, the daughter of John and Delores LaGessee Goodman. Carol attended St. Joseph Grade School and Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School and received a bachelor's degree from Eastern Illinois University in Charleston.
