Caroline V. Wagner, 94, of Kankakee, died Wednesday (May 22, 2013) at Presence Heritage Village in Kankakee. Visitation will be from 11 a.m. Friday until the 2 p.m. funeral service at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. Chaplain Carol DiZeo will officiate.

Mrs. Wagner was a retired teacher. She taught in a country school south of Aroma Park, and taught 25 years in Kankakee, St. Anne and Bradley. She received a Bachelor of Science degree from Olivet Nazarene University. Wagner Council, the Indiana Ladies Auxiliary of the UCT, Women of the Moose, and Kankakee County Retired Teachers Association.

Surviving are one son and daughter-in-law, Stewart and Mary Wagner, of St. Anne; three grandchildren, Rhonda and Paul Zasimowich, Edwin and Kelly Wagner, and Kent Wagner, all of Virginia; and six great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by one son, Edwin; one brother, Barton; infant brother, Neal; one sister, Eunyce Ross; and one grandson, Scott.
