Carolyn M. Moriarty, age 78 of Bourbonnais, passed away Friday August 25, 2017 at Presence Our Lady of Victory Nursing Home. She was born June 12, 1939 in Chicago, the daughter of Harry M. and Isabelle B. Bourelle Barker. She married John E. Moriarty on August 24, 1963 at St. Patrick Catholic Church in Kankakee. He preceded her in death on July 29, 2005.

Carolyn retired from Bourbonnais School District in 1993. She has also worked at The Daily Journal for over 10 years. She was a parishioner of Maternity B.V.M. Catholic Church in Bourbonnais, where she served as a past church organist at Maternity B.V.M. and also at St. Rose Catholic Church in Kankakee.
