She died Monday (March 20, 2006) at the Miller Center. Mrs. Taylor was a teacher for 43 years at Salina Township Country School, Bonfield and Kankakee public schools, retiring in 1969. She was born Oct. 12, 1909, in her farm home in Bonfield, the daughter of Fred and Caroline Rantz Bally. Her husband, Francis J. Taylor, whom she married Aug. 23, 1947 at St. Patrick's Catholic Church, died June 3, 1983. She was a member of the Bonfield First United Methodist Church, the Kankakee Historical Society and the Kankakee Retired Teachers. She loved reading, bird watching and painting. Surviving are one sister-in-law, Mary Taylor of Kankakee; nephews and nieces, Vernon Bally, Fred Bally, Ann Gladys, Winifred Thomas, Mary Pat Barney, Ed Taylor and Dick Taylor. Deceased are one brother, Rantz Bally; three sisters, Bonnie E. Ledesky, Winifred H. Bally, Catheryn L. Black; three nieces, Catherine Harris, Melba Larkin and Mary Lou Schranz; and one nephew, Charles Bally.
