Cathy Hall Natschke, age 68, of Bourbonnais passed away Friday, March 20, 2020 at her home. She was born April 15, 1951 in Kankakee, the daughter of Wayne & Venita (VadeBoncoeur) Hall. Cathy had been a retail clerk for nearly 20 years. She was a 1969 graduate of Eastridge High School in Kankakee. She was an avid bird watcher and took part in the CBC bird count. She also tracked migrating birds that passed through the area. Cathy enjoyed writing poetry, biking at the Kankakee River State Park, and walking the trails at Perry Farm. She was a wonderful grandmother and enjoyed nurturing the entire family.

Scott L. Natschke, age 71, of Bourbonnais, passed away Saturday, April 16, 2022 at his home. He was born May 14, 1950 in Kankakee, the son of Eldred & Eunice Pilotte Natschke. Scott was a 1968 graduate of Bishop McNamara High School in Kankakee and attended Kankakee Community College. He worked as a mechanical engineer for the Wabtec/Cardwell Westinghouse Corporation in Chicago for 43 years, retiring in 2016. Scott was a drummer. He was an avid Chicago sports fan.
