Cecil B. Martin, 82, of Bourbonnais, died Saturday (Dec. 13, 2008) at ManorCare Health Services, Kankakee. Visitation will be from 10 a.m. Tuesday until the noon services at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home in Bourbonnais. The Rev. Hank Roso will officiate.
