



Charles "Babe" Greenfield

September 3, 1916 - January 24, 2012

Charles J. "Babe" Greenfield, 95, of Bourbonnais, died Tuesday (Jan. 24, 2012) at Bradley Royale Health Care Center. Visitation will be from 3 p.m. to 8 p.m. today at the Clancy-Gernon Funeral Home, Bourbonnais. Cremation rites will be accorded following the visitation.

Inurnment will be at 11 a.m. Saturday, Feb. 4, at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Worth. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the American Heart Association.

Mr. Greenfield worked for Chicago Bridge & Iron Co. from 1940 to 1979. He was born Sept. 3, 1916, in Chicago, the son of Charles and Catherine Fleming Greenfield. His wife, the former Emily "Millie" Valauskas, preceded him in death. He was a veteran of the U.S. Navy, serving during World War II. He was a member of Maternity BVM Catholic Church, Bourbonnais, and a member of the Moose since 1974.

Surviving are one brother, Gerald Greenfield; and one sister-in-law, Betty Stalun. He was the fond uncle, great-uncle and great-great-uncle of many.

He was preceded in death by his parents; five sisters, Irene Porter, LaVerne Gaertner, Neola Kletzke, Margaret Kletzke and Patricia Kletzke; three brothers, Robert Greenfield, James Greenfield and William Greenfield; and

one sister-in-law, Lorraine Greenfield.
