Charles "Chuck" A. Nolte, 81, of Kankakee, passed away Saturday (July 11, 2015) at his home.

He was born June 19, 1934, in Kankakee, to Charles W. and Lorretta Webb Nolte. He married Charlotte Blanchette Raimondo on July 20, 1971.

Chuck was a member of St. Martin of Tours Catholic Church in Kankakee. He was a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, stationed at Chanute Air Force Base for four years. He retired after 35 years, in 2000, with the Kankakee City Police. He retired after 43 years working security at Peoples Bank. He also enjoyed gardening and collecting bears.

Survivors include his wife, of Kankakee; sons, Charles L.
