



## Charles "Chuck" V. Wilson Jr.

Charles "Chuck" V. Wilson Jr., 70, of Manteno, passed away Saturday (Apr. 30, 2022) at Ascension St. Mary's Hospital in Kankakee.

He was born June 28, 1951 in Shawneetown, the son of Charles and Freda (nee Boulds) Wilson. Chuck was married to Patricia Palmer on Sep. 6, 1975 at the Reddick United Methodist Church.

Surviving are his wife, Patricia Wilson, of Manteno and The Villages, FL; his daughter, Kimberly Wilson Bukowski and his son-in-law, Trent Bukowski.

"Papa" Chuck is also survived by three loving grandchildren- Logan, Landon and Tessa Bukowski of Manteno.
