Charles E. Cyr, "Charlie," died on Friday, March 8, 2019 at Riverside Medical Center in Kankakee, IL. Charlie was born on July 3, 1944 to Floyd D. and Laura A. (Nickerson) Cyr in Kankakee, IL. He married Jean Henry on July 5, 1969 in Normal, IL. He worked as an agriculture teacher at Peotone High School for 35 years before his retirement. He farmed his family's land in St. Anne. He also worked part-time for both Will County Auxiliary Police and the Peotone Police Department. He served as District 2 Director, Vice President and President of the IAVAT. He was a member of Single Action Shooter Society. He was a member and former board member of First Presbyterian Church of St. Anne.

Charlie is survived by his wife, Jean, of St. Anne, IL; one son, Tim (Debbie) Cyr of Chebanse, IL; one daughter, Cindy (Jim Howell) Harvey of Joliet, IL; three grandchildren, Miranda Harvey and Rhianna and Kylie Cyr and two dogs, Beau and Mickey. He was preceded in death by his parents and his son-in-law, Michael Harvey.

A memorial visitation will be held on Tuesday, March 12, 2019 at First Presbyterian Church of St. Anne from 3:00 p.m. until the time of Charlie's memorial service at 7:00 p.m. Cremation rites have been accorded.

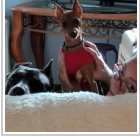
