Charlotte L. Olthoff, age 102 of Bourbonnais, passed away Monday, May 27, 2024 at The Grove Riverside Senior Living in Bourbonnais.

She was born June 23, 1921 in South Holland, the daughter of Harry & Rose Brouwers Dykstra.

In 1941, Charlotte married Willard Olthoff in South Holland. He preceded her in death on February 29, 2000.
