Surviving are three sons and daughters-in-law, Harold Jr. and Patricia Carstens of California, Thomas and Sheila Carstens of Bourbonnais, Michael and Cathy Carstens of Kankakee; four daughters and two sons-in-law, Sylvia and Ronald Nickles, Patricia and Roger LaMore, and Lorraine Carstens, all of Bourbonnais, Phyllis Lewis of Awatucki, Ariz.; 18 grandchildren; 26 great-grandchildren; and two great-great-grandchildren.
